Dance Guidelines and Expectations

REQUIREMENTS

All students are required to present their school ID card upon entrance to the dance. No exceptions will be granted. If a student has misplaced a school ID card they will be required to request a replacement in advance for a fee of \$5.00.

DRESS CODE POLICY FOR DANCES

Students in violation of the Dress Code will not be allowed to enter the dance. Students found to be in violation following entrance to the dance will be removed from the dance.

- All undergarments must be worn and covered at all times
- Tank tops must fit snugly on the sides and top; no “bandana” shirts may be worn
- No plunging necklines students must wear appropriate undergarments
- Midriffs may not show above the belly button
- Skirts must be mid-thigh or longer
- No swim suits may be worn
- Spandex may only be worn underneath other garments
- See-through or sheer material may not be worn

DANCE REGULATIONS

Unsafe, lewd or vulgar dancing is not permitted. There are five basic rules for every dance:

1. No “freak” dancing / dancing that imitates sexual activity
2. No crowd “surfing”
3. No “mosh pits” / slam dancing
4. Other than shoes or jackets or other wraps, clothing may not be removed.
5. No use or possession of controlled substances at any school activity.

Students who violate any of these rules will be removed from the dance and barred from the next dance. WESTERN SIERRA may request assistance from law enforcement. **Any student and / or guest who uses alcohol or any other controlled substance prior to coming to a dance or at a school dance will be suspended and barred from the next school dance.**

- Current student ID card is mandatory to attend the dance. Replacement cards may be requested in advance from the main office for a fee of \$5.00.
- Doors will close 15 minutes after the stated dance start time. Once a student leaves the dance, he/she will not be re-admitted to the dance.
- Students must be picked up no later than **15 minutes** after the dance ends.
- Students are to be in designated dance areas. Students found outside of the designated areas will be escorted off the property and a parent will be called.
- All regulations pertaining to student conduct in school and in dances are in effect.
- Anyone suspected of substance abuse will not be admitted, will be subject to disciplinary action and will be unable to attend the next dance.
- If a student is removed from the dance for inappropriate dancing, intoxication or possession, he/she will not be allowed to attend the next dance.
- No purses, bags or backpacks will be allowed into the dance. Students may check them into the proper facilities at the door.
- Guests from other schools will not be admitted.
